E. Do NOT perform any additional procedures without speaking with me first. I understand that this means my animal may need to be re-sedated at a later date to resolve the issue, and more cost will be incurred. PLEASE BE AVAILABLE BY PHONE if you select this option.

- On Spay/Neuter days, Spay Me! focuses specifically on the spaying and neutering of healthy animals with normal anatomy. If you have further concerns, please discuss scheduling a wellness appointment with the clinic.
- Spay Me! does not routinely place intravenous catheters or run intravenous fluids on our surgical patients. No advanced diagnostics
 will be performed prior to surgery. Some medical conditions, which may increase the patient's risk, may not be detected/detectable
 without such testing. I am solely responsible for informing SpayMe! staff of any preexisting conditions. I understand that preanesthetic
 bloodwork is recommended for animals age 7 years and older.
- The surgery performed is a major surgery and like all major surgeries has inherent risks that are associated with anesthesia, drug
 administration, and surgical. Pregnant females or those in heat may be spayed but the risk to the animals may be increased. Every
 reasonable precaution and the best possible medical care will be exercised while the animal is a patient at our clinic. This may
 include the decision not to perform surgery at the veterinarian's discretion.
- I understand the inherent risks of failing to maintain current vaccinations and waive all claims arising out of, or connected with, the
 performance of this operation due to such failure. I understand, in particular, that if the animal develops kennel cough or other upper
 respiratory infections after surgery, I am responsible for treatment at my own cost.
- I understand the animal will receive a small green tattoo on his/her underside to show that he/she has been sterilized.
- In rare cases, male animals may have undescended testicle(s). This is called cryptorchidism and it can naturally occur in some animals. In order for these animals to be neutered, I understand that the veterinarian will need to perform additional surgical procedures and an additional cost will be incurred.
- 4th year vet students participate in externships at this clinic. They work directly under the supervising veterinarian *performing* spays and neuters for rescue and publicly owned animals, with owner consent. <u>Please let us know if you do not consent to a student</u> <u>performing supervised surgery on your pet.</u>

- Shelter from the Storm and Spay Me! do not endorse any practices concerning the care or housing of animals that in any way violates any local ordinances
- Unposted Fees: In some instances, charges for services rendered may still be in the processing stage when I pick my animal up. I agree to pay for these charges when a final bill is received.
- If live fleas are found on your pet, a topical preventative will be applied and a small charge (per pet) will be added. This is for their
 safety as well as the safety of other pets in clinic today. (**Cats getting the Outdoor Package are treated automatically at no additional
 charge.)
- **OUTDOOR CATS ONLY: Eartipping is the universal sign of an altered feral cat. I understand and agree to the eartipping with the Outdoor Package. If you do not wish for your cat to receive an EAR TIP, you must select the indoor cat package.
- I agree to allow Spay Me! Clinic to take photographs of my pet and grant permission for these to be used by Spay me! Clinic on social media platforms, promotional materials, and other publications made by Spay Me! Clinic. If you do not consent, you MUST inform staff that you do not wish to have your pet photographed.
- I acknowledge that I have received the Post-Surgical Home Care Instructions (available at the end of this form) and will provide
 proper post-surgery monitoring and care for the animal including, but not limited to, the Instructions. Further, I understand that I am
 financially responsible for any post-surgical costs incurred at follow-up visits at Spay Me! or any other veterinary facility.

By signing, I acknowledge that I have read, understood and agree to all the terms listed above and **on the reserve side** and confirm that all the information given on this form is correct. I request that Spay Me! Clinic provides services for my animal. I agree to waive any or all claims against SFTS, the officers, employees and volunteers in the event of escape, injury, complications, or death of my animal. I have read, understand and agree to follow all aftercare instructions provided by Spay Me! and/or my veterinarian. I will seek the care of a veterinarian or Spay Me! for any suspected post surgical complications and bear full financial responsibility for any expenses incurred. I hereby declare under penalty of perjury that I am the owner (or authorized agent) of the above described animal(s) and that I have not withheld any information regarding known pre-existing medical conditions.

Surgery:

Female Dogs and Cats: An incision is made into the abdomen and the ovaries and uterus removed. The incision is closed with internal and absorbable sutures. The sutures are under the skin and do not need to be removed.

Male Dogs: An incision is made in front of or on the scrotum. The testicles are removed through this incision. The incision is closed with internal and absorbable sutures or tissue glue. The sutures are under the skin and do not need to be removed.

Male Cats: An incision is made on the scrotum and both testicles removed. The incision heals together on its own. No stitches need to be removed. Anytime surgery is performed there is a risk of infection or bleeding, but we try to minimize this risk.

Anesthesia:

During surgery, all animals are placed under general anesthesia and given pain medication. However, we do not run pre-operative bloodwork or place an IV fluid line. Most animals do just fine. However, anesthesia does have inherent risks involved, the same as a human. In some circumstances, the worst case scenario can include death. If we have a complication, treatment is started immediately and you will be contacted. Unfortunately, we cannot make any guarantees of survival. Our complication rate is very low, so this is unlikely to happen. It is our responsibility to make you aware of the inherent risk of surgery and the use of anesthesia.

Tattoo:

A small, green, linear tattoo is applied to the belly after surgery to indicate neutered status.

SQ Fluids:

Subcutaneous fluids are administered to all cats after surgery, under the skin, between the shoulder blades. It is usually absorbed by time of discharge.

Post-Surgical Care Instructions

Please notify Spay Me! Clinic or your regular veterinarian if any of the following occurs:

- Loss of appetite for more than two days
- Refusal to drink water for more than one day
- Depression, lethargy, weakness or pain
- Vomiting after the first 24 hours following surgery
- Diarrhea for more than 24 hours

<u>Diet</u>

- Feed small amount in the evening after surgery.
- Feed regular diet in the morning after surgery.

Activity

- Restrict exercise no running, jumping 10-14 days.
- High-energy dogs should be leash walked and kenneled.

Incision

- Watch incision for swelling, redness or drainage. Apply nothing to the incision.
- Do not allow excessive licking at the incision
- Suture material is absorbable. It is buried and will dissolve.
- Keep the incision, and your pet, clean and dry.
- Your animal will be given a small green tattoo on incision site (male cats on the abdomen) to show proof of spay/neuter.

<u>Pain</u>

- Your pet has been medicated for pain while at the clinic, this can last up to 24 hours.
- DO NOT give your pet any over the counter pain medicine ie: aspirin. It is neither necessary nor safe for your pet.
- If you feel that your pet is exceptionally prone to painfulness, you can purchase 3 days of pain medication to take home.

Feral Cats

- Must be kept at indoor temperatures (60 to 70 degrees F) for 48 hours before being re-released.
- Be sure that they are eating and drinking before release.

If you feel your animal may be experiencing difficulty after surgery, re-checks are available and can be scheduled by calling 608-224-1400.

There may be an additional charge for re-checks, medications, etc.
